
We will have a special treat for moms to pick up at morning drop-off on Friday, May 6 to celebrate Mother's Day.

We hope you will plan to use this special time to love on your child's teachers a little extra. Also, keep an eye out for an email containing more details with opportunities to encourage the staff as a whole.






Outside play is a crucially important part of our day, so a couple of things will help your child be best prepared:

Vacation Benefit

After being enrolled for a full year, families with accounts in good standing are permitted a week of vacation without charge each calendar year. Vacation is defined as five consecutive school days. A written notice must be given to the Director two weeks prior. The note may be handwritten and submitted in person or sent via email. Vacation credit will not be granted if the request is made less than two weeks in advance, with no exception. In addition, any changes that need to be made to your vacation request must be submitted at least two weeks in advance.

During the use of a vacation credit, the child may not be in attendance at the Center.
